Certification

The CatanDog's Tag has received the following certifications:

USA: Establishment Number 74920-ESP-001. This certification was granted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency in 2002.

This registration defines the CatanDog's Tag as a pesticide on the grounds that it is a device that falls under the FIFRA definition of a pesticide. FIFRA defines a device as "any instrument or contrivance (other than a firearm) which is intended for trapping, destroying, repelling, or mitigating any pest or any other form of plant or animal life."

The PZN registration was also granted in 2002. Germany and Austria have their own and specific barcode for their pharmaceutical industry. It is called the Pharmazentralnummer or Pharma-Zentral-Nummer which is abbreviated as PZN and means Pharmaceutical Central/General Number. It is mainly used as an identification tool for medicine and health-care products in Germany and some of the other German-speaking countries.

Therefore, we can demonstrate that in the USA and in parts of Europe the CatanDog's tag is regarded as a pesticide and in other parts as a pharmaceutical product.
